

OHSU Global Health Center Frequent Flyer Donation Form

The OHSU Global Health Center Frequent Flyer Donation Form allows members of the community to support the efforts of students and faculty wishing to volunteer in global health. Activities include research, field activities, service projects, and life affirming experiences that have positive impact on education and global health. The OHSU Global Health Frequent Flyer Donation Program allows donors a special opportunity to support these efforts by providing airline awards and travel tickets to students with plans to travel and improve global health. Awards may be used to travel internationally or domestically. A student or faculty member may present important research at a local global health conference devoted to an international subject matter.

Donors can donate the number of miles needed towards an award ticket for a round trip flight either to an international or gateway city. The number of miles required will range from as low as 25,000 for domestic travel, to international trips that require from 35,000 to 100,000 miles.
