

## Oregon State University Pharm. D. Students—Important Information

Your program at OHSU is based on an agreement between OSU and OHSU. Based on that agreement the following applies:

OSU students in the Pharm.D. program in the **third year** will be assessed the student health fee and are required to carry the mandatory OHSU student group health insurance for the academic year that they are at OHSU. The insurance will be in effect from the first day of the month in which their OHSU classes begin until midnight of the last day of the month in which their 3<sup>rd</sup> year Pharm.D. program ends. Like all OHSU students, 3<sup>rd</sup> year Pharm.D. students should check with the ODS Health Plan with questions about any aspect of the group insurance plan, and should check with the Student Health Service (the health plan administrator) for any questions regarding their personal eligibility, dates of coverage, or if they experience problems with claims. OSU students in the Pharm.D. program in the **fourth year**, will be assessed the health fee, entitling them to obtain care in the OHSU Student Health Service for any term that they are training at OHSU during their fourth year. *However, these fourth year students are exempt from and are not eligible to enroll in the OHSU student group health insurance plan.* If you are going to be a fourth year student in the OSU Pharm.D. program, please check with your **OSU administration** regarding your options for student group health insurance as an OSU student during your fourth year if you do not have health coverage through an employer.
