**Organizational/Biographical Information**

Naida F. Hoffman Hurlburt was born in Satanta, Kansas on June 19, 1915. Ms. Hurlburt attended Satanta High School and practiced as a student nurse in Garden City, Kansas at St. Catherine's Hospital. She served in the Army Nurse Corp. during WWII in the 46<sup>th</sup> General Hospital. She was stationed at Fort Riley, Kansas, Oran, North Africa and Besancon, France between July 15, 1942 and February 6, 1946. She was appointed 1<sup>st</sup> Lieutenant on April 16, 1945.

**Scope, Content and Arrangement**

The materials consist of a nurse's official dress uniform (WWII) with insignia and unit citations; nurse's field jacket; fatigue shirt; musset bag; web belt; accessories; documents, financial statements; memorabilia; paraphernalia and ephemera related to WWII and the 46<sup>th</sup> General Hospital and 2 photographs of Naida F. Hoffman Hurlburt.
