

Jeopardy Job Description

1st, 2nd, and 3rd Jeopardy

Availability:

- Please be available on pager 24 hours a day; you may have pages forwarded to your cell phone or home number if you are concerned about receiving a page (your pager status can be “2” (in hospital on page) or “5” (out of hospital and available)).
- Please do not travel greater than 60 miles from the hospital while you are on jeopardy; you should be within a 1 hour driving distance from the hospital.
- You do not need to know why you are being called in. This is to protect the confidentiality of you and your colleagues.
- After completing a shift on jeopardy, please go home, rest, and turn your pager off or set to “7” (out of hospital not available). PLEASE REMEMBER TO TURN YOUR PAGER BACK ON 10 HOURS AFTER LEAVING THE HOSPITAL. There is a possibility that you may be called in again the next day, so we need to make sure you are well rested and are off 10 hours between shifts.
- You are guaranteed 10 hours off between shifts.

- You are expected to be at morning report (or Grand Rounds on Tuesdays) and noon conference every day if you are not jeopardized.
