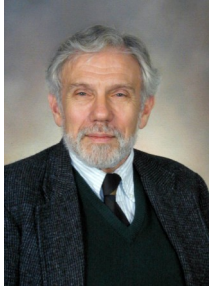


## Continuing Medical Education recognizes outstanding faculty
