

Ground Transportation Tips

From Portland International Airport you can ride MAX Light Rail (www.trimet.org) directly to downtown in approximately 30 minutes. Trains depart from the east end, lower level of the airport every 15 minutes. The cost for a one-way ticket is \$1.95. Once downtown, other public transportation options include the Portland streetcar, taxis and the city bus. We suggest that when making room reservations, ask for explicit directions and information on the best mode of transportation to use for reaching your hotel.

For door-to-door shuttle service from PDX www.portlandairportpdx.com/ to your hotel, please inquire at the Airport Information Booth located near the Baggage Claim area upon your arrival. This service is available from 8:00 a.m. to Midnight. Pricing may vary; however, a one-way ticket should run about \$24.

Cab fare from Portland International Airport to the downtown area is approximately \$25-27. Cab fare from downtown or the Nob Hill area to OHSU will cost approximately \$7. Another option is to catch the #8 bus: it will deliver you directly to OHSU's front door. The bus runs every 15 minutes from the downtown Transit Mall and the fare is \$1.95.
