

Portland Weather

The area's geography provides shelter from most severe weather. The average rainfall is 37 inches a year (less than Atlanta or Baltimore). Portland experiences definite changes of seasons. Summers are mild, with temperatures averaging in the mid-70s and very little precipitation. In fact, only 3% of the annual rainfall occurs in July and August with 9% falling between June and September. Short periods of hot, dry weather (mid to upper 90s) occur during the summer.
