ADDENDUM TO CURRICULUM VITAE

Types of surgery in my current practice in addition to bread and butter general surgery:

1. Peripheral vascular surgery. I have not done access surgery as we had no local dialysis.
2. Laparoscopic surgery, general and advanced including fundoplication, colectomy, splenectomy,, Adrenalectomy, and selected other cases including bowel obstruction when appropriate.
3. Non-cardiac thoracic surgery
4. Sentinel lymph node biopsy for breast and melanoma by IRB
5. Scintographic localization of parathyroid adenomas/minimal incisions
6. All endoscopy including EGD and dilatation, colonoscopy, bronchoscopy, mediastinoscopy and common bile duct endoscopy
7. Limited trauma surgery as appropriate to a smaller hospital up to and including repair of thoracic aortic lacerations and rupture
8. I had planned to recertify for the American Board of Surgery in 2003 but didn't have the required number of hours of continuing medical education not realizing that my fellowship would have qualified me to take the exam. I am taking the exam in Sept 2004 and will technically be uncertified from July 15 until I have passed the exam.
9. I have taught Introduction to Clinical Medicine for the WWAMI Medicine Program, University of Washington for the past 12 years with emphasis on physical examination. Additionally, I have been a preceptor for the WWAMI Program for the past 16 years (1985-2001) with oversight responsibility for one student per academic semester.
