Situated in Portland, Oregon, the Oregon Health & Science University (OHSU) enjoys a large and expanding basic and clinical research program. The institution has recently opened a 250,000 square foot Biomedical Research Building and the Center for Health and Healing, a 15 floor combined clinical and research facility. These two new buildings are connected by a landmark, 3 minute tram ride. OHSU is also home to the OHSU Cancer Institute, celebrating its tenth year as an NCI-designated Cancer Center and headed by Dr. Brian Druker. OHSU was one of the inaugural recipients of an NIH Clinical Translational Science Award.

The Division of Hematology and Medical Oncology has strong and diverse clinical programs including, but by no means limited to, hematological malignancies, prostate cancer, gastrointestinal cancers, sarcoma, lung and breast cancer. The Division is also home to an accredited fellowship training program. The Division supports 28 faculty members and 9 mid level providers. The Center for Health & Healing provides multi-disciplinary care for solid tumor and benign hematology while The Center for Hematologic Malignancies provides comprehensive care for patients with hematologic malignancies, including autologous and allogeneic stem cell transplantation.

We seek academic BC hematologist/oncologists who demonstrate the background, focus and drive to excel, as well as the desire to deliver the best care possible to cancer patients in a clinical research environment. Our ideal candidate must possess a proven track record of teaching, basic, clinical, or population research and patient care excellence.
