

**RESOLUTION NO. 2006-03-02
OREGON HEALTH & SCIENCE UNIVERSITY
BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

WHEREAS, OHSU is completing construction of a 335,000 square foot, state-of-the-art patient care facility (the "PCF"), designed to ultimately include 120 additional hospital beds, 12 new operating rooms, and ambulatory care space including the Center for Women's Health and the Center for Hematologic Malignancies, and positioning OHSU to more effectively and efficiently deliver high quality health care to the people of the State of Oregon;

WHEREAS, the opening of the PCF in mid-2006 will represent the culmination of many years of project and program planning, design work and fundraising, and the achievement of a significant milestone toward realization of a vision of excellence articulated for OHSU by Dr. Peter O. Kohler, President of OHSU;

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to recognize Dr. Kohler for his vision for OHSU, his dedication to the health care, research and educational missions of OHSU, his many years of service as President of OHSU and his transformative leadership of the institution, by naming the PCF "Peter O. Kohler Pavilion";

WHEREAS, current OHSU policy requires that in order to name an OHSU building after a living person, the Board must find that unusually meritorious reasons exist for doing so; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that Dr. Kohler's vision for, dedication to, and record of accomplishments with, OHSU constitute those unusually meritorious reasons;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of Oregon Health & Science University as follows:


The PCF is hereby named "Peter O. Kohler Pavilion."
