Community Health Improvement Partnership Responsibilities

- Become Educated about CHIP Process
- Become Educated about Local Health Care Issues, System, and Financing
- Represent a Sector of the Community
- Increase Citizen Participation
- Select Issues
- Generate Alternatives
- Participate Fully in Meetings
- Others



Select Ten Activities

- Share process information and get a commitment
- Provide CHIP Coordinator with Names and Address
- Interview five of the members one-on-one using approved tool
- Personal invitations to the Community Visioning Meeting
- Provide information regarding plans and listen to response



Choosing the “Select Ten”

- Citizens within your sector
- Consider your sector broadly
- Seek diversity (demographic, socio-economic, geographic etc..)
- Consider non-traditional sector members - affiliated businesses, organizations, vendors



Managing the “Select Ten”

- Serve as liaison between “Select Ten” and the CHIP
- Provide “Select Ten” with information regarding the overall goals and objectives of the intervention
- Provide educational material as necessary
- Establish routine means of contact
