- Represent a sector of the community
- Increase citizen participation
- Select issues
- Generate alternatives

# Select Ten Activities

- Share process information and get a commitment
- Provide CHIP Coordinator with names and addresses
- Interview five of the members one-on-one using approved tool
- Personal invitations to the Community Visioning Meeting
- Provide information regarding plans and listen to response



# Choosing the “Select Ten”

- Citizens within your sector
- Consider your sector broadly
- Seek diversity (demographic, socio-economic, geographic, etc..)
- Consider non-traditional sector members - affiliated businesses, organizations, and vendors



# Managing the “Select Ten”

- Serve as liaison between “Select Ten” and CHIP
- Provide “Select Ten” with information regarding the overall goals and objectives of the intervention
- Provide educational material as necessary
- Establish routine means of contact
