Dr. Brazelton using his concept of "touchpoints" or the universal predictable times that occur just before a surge of rapid growth in development highlights how a professional can use such times to reach into the family system, offer support and prevent future problems. He discusses how nurses can use modeling to achieve "best behavior" from parents and how the nurses teaching and modeling increases parents confidence in their ability to parent and better understanding of newborn behavior.
