

Parents and Children Together (PACT): An ADHD Research Study

How PACT Works

PACT is a study to learn about the best ways to support families with children who have ADHD. PACT compares two approaches to supporting families with children with ADHD. Families have a 50% chance of being selected into one of two groups: (1) a home-based approach where a nurse visits your home at regular intervals to provide services that families with children with ADHD need, or (2) an information-based approach where families will be provided with factual information about ADHD.

PACT Enrollment

There is no cost for participating in the study. Mothers will receive \$50 gift cards every 6 months for 18 months for participating in this study no matter which group they are assigned. Additional family members will receive \$10 gift cards each time they complete a short survey.
