BIKE INCENTIVE POLICY

In order to qualify for the OHSU Bike Incentive, you must meet the following requirements:

- 1) There are two opportunities for incentives. In order to collect either incentive, you must present your completed commuter card to the OHSU Parking Office or OHSU Parking Information Booth.
 - A. In order to qualify for the \$25 cash incentive, you may use a combination of your bike and Tri-met. A combination of biking and carpooling is not accepted. If you are currently in a carpool, please contact the OHSU Parking Office for details on how the incentive could work for you.
 - B. In order to qualify for the \$50 cash incentive, we require you to commute both directions on your bicycle to and from OHSU. A combination of biking and bussing is not accepted, so if you have a Tri-met PASSport, you are not eligible for this larger incentive. As well, a combination of biking and carpooling is not accepted. If you are currently in a carpool, please contact the OHSU Parking Office for details on how the incentive could work for you.
- 2) You must be an OHSU employee or OHSU student.
- 3) You must live at least 2 miles away from the OHSU campus to be eligible for this bike incentive.
- 4) Bike Commuter/Incentive passes are non-transferable. OHSU Parking Department is not responsible for lost cards.
- 5) If it is discovered that this bike commuter card is being abused in any way – i.e., punches being forged, commuter not being truthful about commute, coming through the booth more than once daily to have the card punched – the card is subject to revocation, and the commuter subject to termination within the program.
- 6) This incentive is only available for employees of the Marquam Hill Campus.
- 7) Punches for your card are only available M-F from 6AM to 8PM.
- 8) Current locations for having your bike car punched are the OHSU Parking Information Booth, the OHSU Parking Office, the OHSU Fitness and Sports Center, and the Casey Eye Institute Parking Booth.
