

OHSU PARKING DEPARTMENT VEHICLE STICKER POLICY

It is the responsibility of any OHSU parker to display the correct OHSU Parking Sticker at all times. Stickers are issued to specific individuals, by name or by vehicle license plate. Stickers are non-transferable.

In the event of a Parking Sticker change, affected parkers will be notified through US mail at their home address, 30 days prior to the change. There will also be broadcasts through the OHSU email, voice mail, and newspaper. Warnings will be issued for expired parking permits up to 30 days following the expiration date noted on the OHSU parking stickers. After this period, these permits will become null and void and will be subject to ticketing By OHSU Parking Patrol. Payroll deductions will also be terminated if the permit has not Been renewed after 60 days from the expiration date noted on the parking sticker, which Will result in removal from the OHSU Parking Program. Parking deductions will not be stopped prior to this date unless the OHSU Parking Office is directly notified of the desire to stop the parking fee, and the OHSU parking stickers are returned. Before being considered for reinstatement as an eligible parker on the OHSU campus, the individual would need to contact the Parking Office and reapply for the parking program, subject to applicable policies, procedures, and waiting lists.

Lost parking stickers can be replaced for a \$30.00 replacement fee. In order to avoid this fee, any valid OHSU parking sticker must be returned to the OHSU Parking Office.

Any exceptions to this policy will only be considered after review by the OHSU Parking Appeals/Review Committee.
