

## Macintosh VPN Install Instructions

*There is no option for VPN access in OS 9.*

### **Installing the Cisco VPN software.**

#### *Requirements:*

Macintosh running OS X version 10.1.5 or greater.

High speed connection at home (DSL, cable, etc.).

This newest version of the Cisco VPN software installed.

The admin password is required for the machine you are installing this software on.

1. Double click on the .mpkg file in this disk image to launch into the installer.  
This will provide you with all the software needed to connect. The disk image includes the file that is required to connect to OHSU's specific VPN.
2. Once installed, import the file to connect to OHSU's specific VPN settings.
3. Run the VPN software and click on the 'Import' button in the main screen.
4. Go into the 'Profiles' folder in the disk image and choose the only file in there and click 'Import'.

When you highlight OHSU\_VPN and hit connect, the VPN client will ask you for a login name and password. This is your Netware login name and password. Your context is not necessary.

Once that is provided you should be able to connect. You will be able to connect to all OHSU's network resources from home just as if you were connected here at work.

**\*Note** you cannot connect to the VPN on campus. You must be already connected to the internet at home prior to using this software.
