

## **David Buckley receives American Cancer Society Mentored Research Scholar Grant in Applied and Clinical Research**



David I. Buckley, MD, research assistant professor in the departments of Family Medicine and Medical Informatics/Clinical Epidemiology, has been awarded a \$706,000 Mentored Research Scholar Grant in Applied and Clinical Research by the American Cancer Society. He received this career development award for research into cancer screening and prevention for disabled adults in rural primary care practice. Dr. Buckley is a research investigator with the Oregon Rural Practice-based Research Network (ORPRN). The research will be conducted in ORPRN, and in collaboration with the Rehabilitation Research and Training Center (RRTC) at OHSU. His mentors for the grant include Patricia A. Carney, PhD, professor of Family Medicine and Associate Director for Population Studies at the OHSU Cancer Institute, and Cynthia Morris, PhD, professor and Vice Chair of Medical Informatics/Clinical Epidemiology and Research Director of ORPRN.
