Directions To The Oregon Health & Science University School of Dentistry

From the North: Travel south on I-5; take I-405 south across the Willamette River via the Fremont Bridge (see signs from I-5 that say Beaverton/St. Helens). Follow the signs to City Center, **not** St. Helens. Take the 6th Avenue exit and get in the far right lane. This lane will eventually force you to turn right. You will pass a long park and come to a stoplight where you will see a gas station (to the left) and the Carousel Restaurant (to the right). Turn left on to Terwilliger Blvd. Go about 1/4 mile to the Casey Eye Institute. Turn right. ****See below.***

From the South: Travel north on I-5. Take the Terwilliger exit and turn left at the light. Travel about 4 miles on Terwilliger. You will cross Barbur Blvd. and Capitol Highway (big intersections); stay on Terwilliger. You will pass the Chart House Restaurant (to your right) and about a mile further, a sign that says Veterans Administration (to your left). The VA sign lets you know you are close! The next left turn is the Casey Eye Institute. Turn left. ****See below.***

From the West: Take the Sunset Highway (Highway 26) into Portland, and get in the right-hand lane prior to going through the tunnel. Follow the signs to Salem, I-405 South. The right-hand lane will put you on I-405 South. Take the Sixth Avenue exit and get in the right-hand lane. This lane will force you to turn right. You will pass a long park and come to a stoplight where you will see a gas station (to your left) and the Carousel Restaurant (to your right). Turn left on to Terwilliger Blvd. Go about 1/4 mile to the Casey Eye Institute. Turn right. ****See below.***

From the East: Travel west on I-84 to the I-5 junction. Take I-5 south toward Salem; cross the Willamette River via the Marquam Bridge, following signs to City Center/Beaverton. Take the SW 6th Avenue exit. Turn left within the first two blocks after coming on 6th Avenue. Go one block and then turn left again onto Broadway. Get in the far right-hand lane. This lane will eventually force you to turn right. You will pass a long park and come to a stoplight where you will see a gas station (to your left) and the Carousel Restaurant (to your right). Turn left on to Terwilliger Blvd. Go about 1/4 mile to the Casey Eye Institute. Turn right. ****See below.***

From Downtown Portland: Travel south on Broadway (one way) in downtown Portland and remain in the right-hand lane. You will pass Portland State University. At this point, follow the "**From the East**" instructions above that begin with travel on Broadway.

****From All Directions:*** *The School of Dentistry is the next building on your right after you turn at the Casey Eye Institute. You may park in the metered spaces for free after 5:00 p.m. **Please do not park in car pool, handicapped or 24 hr. reserved parking.** Use the entrance near the parking structure, on the side of the school.*
