Post-Master's PhD Program of Study

PhD students must submit a Program of Study form according to School of Nursing Policy No. 20-04.11, "PhD Progression: Program of Study and Benchmarks," after completing 37 hours of required core coursework. The Program of Study is required to be submitted prior to scheduling candidacy exams. The Academic Advisor assists the student in planning the Program of Study in a timely manner.

The Program of Study should include the following items:

- Approval page with student's name, Academic Advisor's signature, area of research emphasis, and credit distribution
- Yearly planning pages
- Narrative section in which you describe how your proposed coursework establishes a coherent Program of Study

Submit the original of this packet to your Academic Advisor for signature. Once signed, submit it to the office of Academic Graduate and Interdisciplinary Programs for filing. Attach additional pages as necessary. Be sure to indicate the institution for cognate coursework or transfer credits.

If you have revisions to your Program of Study, indicate these in writing on your copy, obtain your Academic Advisor's or Dissertation Chair's signature of approval, and submit to the office of Academic Graduate and Interdisciplinary Programs.
