

Attention Breast Cancer Survivors!

Research Study Opportunity

Researchers at OHSU School of Nursing are studying how balance, muscle strength, and vision affect fall risk in breast cancer survivors.

WHAT IS INVOLVED?

- Participate in one three to four hour visit and have the evaluation of the following:
 - Body composition, physical fitness, balance and vision. All testing will take place at OHSU
- Participants will be asked to track their falls over 6 months by returning monthly postcards to the study team.

WHO MAY PARTICIPATE?

- Breast cancer survivors who:
 - Are postmenopausal
 - Completed chemotherapy within the last two years OR
 - Had surgery within the last two years and took hormone treatment for at least 6 months.
- Additional eligibility criteria will be assessed during a brief telephone call.
