

FRAUD AWARENESS “PROFESSIONAL COMPLIANCE COURSE

WHO TAKS IT?

Physicians, residents, fellows, nurse practitioners/ physician assistants, psychologist, doctors of osteopathy, any other practitioner that can bill independent services to third party payers. Additionally, administrative staff and billing staff who are involved in billing services to third party payers are also required to take the FRAUD AWARENESS PROFESSIONAL course.

This course is part of the educational component of the OHSU Compliance Program.

COMPLETION DEADLINE

Two months from the date a person starts working at OHSU.

WHERE CAN I TAKE IT?

Most departments have personal computers set up for taking the course. It is also available in the OHSU BICC Library and the Residents Library (in the lounge on the 13th floor of UHS). Please check with your department Administrator to determine the best place to take the course.

In the Main Library (the BICC) go to the curriculum desk and check out headphones. The Computer Support Team is at the BICC Monday-Friday, 8:00am-5:00pm and can assist you in locating the program and getting started.

On the computer desktop is an icon labeled OHSU Library CD-Rom's. Double click on that and chose the icon for Fraud Awareness.

User will need to know their Novell user name and password.
