

## **Training Objectives- Urology PGY1**

### MEDICAL KNOWLEDGE

1. Explain the implications of common urologic symptoms
2. Explain the steps to preoperative preparation of patients for urological surgery.
3. List the various urethral catheters and their appropriate use.
4. Explain the evaluation (including tests and their interpretation) of fluid management problems in the postoperative urologic patient.

### PATIENT CARE

1. Demonstrate ability to gather accurate and complete history and patient examination, including the male genitourinary exam.
2. Demonstrate ability to manage routine pre- and post-operative surgical patients.
3. Demonstrate the proper use of sterile technique when performing or assisting with operative procedures.
