OHSU's Post-Transplant Pharmacy Management Program provides service 24 hours a day by phone at **800-452-1369**, and by e-mail at **pharmacy@ohsu.edu**. Pharmacists and technicians are available Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Pacific time. During these hours pharmacy personnel provide information, refill prescriptions and contact physicians for medication changes. A separate refill line is available for patient convenience.

After hours transplant personnel are available to respond to patient questions and problems.

Post-Transplant Pharmacy Management Program

Oregon Health & Science University's Post-Transplant Pharmacy Management Program helps patients take their medications as their physicians have prescribed them following transplant surgery. Patient noncompliance, or patients not taking their medications as prescribed, is one of the most frequent causes of transplant complications and organ rejection. Our staff works with physicians and nurse coordinators to be sure patients have the right medicines and the right refill access, so they don't run out of their medication.



Medication Prescriptions

OHSU's Post-Transplant Pharmacy Management Program works with OHSU Outpatient Pharmacy to fill all patients' medication needs. The program offers competitive pricing on both prescription and nonprescription medications.

Medical Insurance

The OHSU Pharmacy is able to accept most medication insurance plans. OHSU has a medication assistance program to help patients find financial help to pay for medications they can't afford.

Post-Transplant Nurse Coordinators

OHSU's Post-Transplant Pharmacy Management Program communicates with OHSU's Organ Program nurse coordinators. The OHSU transplant nurse coordinators will notify the pharmacy when physicians make any changes to a patient's medications. The pharmacy will keep the nurses up to date on any medication problems the patients may be having.



Vitamins and Alternative Medicines

OHSU Outpatient Pharmacy stocks a variety of trusted brands of vitamins and alternative medicines for patients who use supplements. When supplements are purchased through OHSU, the pharmacists are able to look for any possible interactions between prescription medications and alternative medicines. *Always inform your physician and pharmacist whenever you are taking herbal or alternative medicines.*



Convenient Mailing

OHSU Outpatient Pharmacy will mail medications to patients when it is not convenient to pick them up in person. This service is for out-of-state as well as in-state patients.
