## 2009 Heart of Doernbecher Auction

**Overview:** The auction brings together approximately 400 community leaders from Oregon and southwest Washington and has raised nearly \$5 million for Doernbecher Children's Hospital since 1998. This year marks the 12<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the event and will feature silent and live auctions, live music, and a touching testimonial from a Doernbecher patient.

**The Goal:** Doernbecher Children's Hospital at Oregon Health & Science University is an unparalleled resource for children from Oregon, southwest Washington and surrounding states. These patients make more than 155,000 visits to the hospital annually. It offers the state's broadest range of healthcare services specifically for children. In the past, funds from the auction have been used to support research and hospital improvements, the expansion of the Kenneth W. Ford Northwest Children's Cancer Center, the Friends of Doernbecher Endowment Fund for Medical Care, the Child Life Endowment Fund and the pediatric emergency department renovation. The money from the 2009 auction will help Doernbecher continue to provide the best care and support for children and families of this region.
