



## Air Quality at Work

You may have wondered about the air you breathe at work... where does it come from; what's in it; how much fresh air do we get; is it too hot/cold/humid/dry?

Environmental Health and Radiation Safety can answer these questions for you. They have sophisticated monitoring equipment that can measure your air and how it varies throughout the day. They can determine if it's right or if some work needs to be done on the system. They can also give you guidance about how to feel more comfortable while at work, in whatever environment you work in.

In general, OHSU buildings consistently provide filtered, comfortable, and healthy air. However, if you are experiencing symptoms outside of what is normal for you, there may be a problem.
