



Emergency? Who to call.

Employees, staff, students, and volunteers all need to know who to call in an emergency. These include fire, hazardous material spills, violence, security threats, bomb threat, crime, medical emergencies, and others.

Who to call depends on where you work:

Marquam Hill:

All requests for emergency assistance must go to **Public Safety at 4-4444**. Public Safety operates twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week, and will coordinate any necessary external responders (e.g.: ambulance). They do this much faster than calling 911 directly.

The only exception is for response from the Code 99 Team within Hospitals and Clinics; in these cases, call 4-8222.

Never dial 911 (or 9-911) from a Marquam Hill location.

West Campus:

All requests for emergency assistance must go to **9-911**.

Hazardous materials spills should be reported to 645-1141, during business hours. After hours, contact 503 494-7744.

Off-campus:

All requests for emergency assistance must go to **9-911**. As soon as practical, and when it is safe to do so, you must also report the problem to Public Safety at 503 494-7744.

Information about security issues and planning for departments or work areas, lost and found items, and training in workplace violence and other safety topics is provided by Public Safety at 503 494-7744.

Information about planning for emergencies, hazard assessment and minimization, and educational tools is provided by Environmental Health and Radiation Safety at 503 494-7795 (Marquam Hill and off-Hill locations) or 503 748-1226 (West Campus).
