

Which iPhone is right for you?

AT&T

Device Features

- Has SIM Card
- 3 antenna slots
- **Cannot** be used as mobile hotspot
- Can use voice & data at the same time
- Will fit in currently available cases & bumpers

Network Considerations

- Extensive international coverage
- Dropped call rate of 4.7% as of 1/2011
- Dropped download rate of 19% as of 1/2011
- HSPA Data Network – ideally faster than EV-DO but speed varies according to location and network
- 450 minutes w/unlimited data and 200 texts messages = \$67.14

Verizon

Device Features

- Does not have SIM card
- 4 antenna slots
- **Can** be used as mobile hotspot
- Cannot use data while making phone calls, can use Wi-Fi
- May not fit in existing cases & bumpers due to redesign

Network Considerations

- International coverage in 40 countries, but more will be added
- Dropped call rate of 1.7% as of 1/2011
- Dropped download rate of 2% as of 1/2011
- EV-DO – technically slower than HSPA but speed varies according to location and network
- 400 minutes w/unlimited data and messaging \$50.41

Both Devices are Identical in the Following Areas

- Dimensions
- Usage times for voice, web and Wi-Fi
- Email synchronization features
- Security features, including OHSU PIN Protection
- Both are 3G devices
- Cost - \$199 for 16GB and \$299 for 32 GB
