





## What's new in Access 2007

New Feature	Description
Getting Started with Access	Splash screen displayed at startup.
The Ribbon	The area at the top of the program window where you choose commands.
Command tabs	Similar commands are grouped together.
Contextual command tabs	Relevant commands are displayed when you're working on specific things, such as creating a table.
Galleries	Certain choices, such as styles on the Ribbon, appear as galleries, so you can see your choices graphically.
Quick Access Toolbar	A single standard toolbar that appears in the Ribbon offering instant, single-click access to the most needed commands, such as Save and Undo.
Navigation Pane	The area on the left side of the window that displays database objects. The Navigation Pane replaces the Database window.
Tabbed documents	Your tables, queries, forms, reports, and macros are displayed as tabbed documents. 
Status bar	A bar at the bottom of the window that displays status information and includes buttons that let you switch views.
Mini toolbar	A toolbar-like element that appears above text you selected, so you can easily change the font or apply formatting.



## What's been replaced in Access 2007

Replaced Feature	Comment
The Office Assistant	The new online help does not include the Office Assistant. For more information about getting help, click the question mark on the Ribbon and then click Getting Help.
Data Access Pages	Access 2007 no longer supports Data Access Pages. If you want to enter data into Access via a Web form, you can deploy your database to a SharePoint Services 3.0 server. If you open a database created with an earlier version of Access (a .mdb file), and that database contains Data Access Pages, you can view the pages in Internet Explorer, but you cannot manipulate those pages.
Detect and Repair	The Detect and Repair feature has been replaced with Microsoft Office Diagnostics, which provides more comprehensive testing and repair capabilities.
The Options command on the Tools menu	Click the Microsoft Office Button  . Options is in the lower right corner of the menu.
