OHSU Staff Tuition Benefit

- Reduced tuition at a number of Oregon University System (OUS) schools, including Portland State, and area community colleges, including Clackamas, Mt. Hood and Portland Community Colleges.
- Parameters for who is eligible (number of hours per week, classification)
- OHSU pays \$50 per undergraduate credit hour and \$150 per graduate credit hour.



How this pencils out

- 4-credit undergrad class at PCC (at \$70/credit) would be \$280 (not including student fees). About \$320-330 with fees.
- OHSU pays \$50/credit, or \$200 of this tuition.
- With student/distance learner fees (approx \$40-50), you end up paying about \$120-130 for the class.
- You essentially save \$200 in this scenario!
- Full-time employees can take up to 8 credit-hours/term at the approved institutions.
- Part-time employees can take up to 4 credit-hours/term at the approved institutions.
