Transportation Options

For OHSU students



OHSU means more options.

The Tram is a 5 minute ride to Marquam Hill and South Waterfront. Consider waterfront connections when planning a trip to the hill, and vice-versa.

Park and rides are free parking lots outside the central city. Park and rides may shorten your trip and help you save money on parking.

Bike share can help with that last mile. Biketown stations are located at South Waterfront and throughout the central city.

Car share allows the flexibility to leave the car at home, saving on gas and parking. Services such as Zipcar, Getaround, Car2Go, ReachNow, Lyft, Uber and Curbed help you complete errands or get home in a hurry.

Mobile apps help plan on the go. Plan a secondary option so you'll have a backup when your normal routine is interrupted.

Walking

Biking

Earn \$20 every 20 trips. Valet is free.

OHSU offers facilities, cash-for-biking, and more. At the Tram, our partner Go By Bike offers free valet protection, loaner bikes, and same-day repair. Anywhere but valet, use a U-lock. Showers and towel service available at Student Center and CLSB (permit fee applies).

Portland Aerial Tram

Free with badge.

The Tram is a 5 minute ride from South Waterfront (SW Moody Ave at SW Gibbs St) to Marquam Hill (Kohler Pavilion).

OHSU Shuttle

Free with badge.

Marquam Hill Shuttle travels downtown every 30 minutes, 7am-5pm. South Waterfront Shuttle runs every 10 minutes on a load-n-go schedule.

Portland Streetcar

Free with badge.

Stops located in central east and westside and South Waterfront. All lines stop at Collaborative Life Sciences Building. NS Line continues south to the Tram.

Public Transit

70% to 95% subsidy annually.

Portland: TriMet (ride.trimet.org); Vancouver: C-TRAN (c-tran.com). Express lines offer more options at peak times. Pick up a transit pass at Transportation and Parking.

Park and Rides

Park and rides are free lots for people who want to: Save money on parking; Shorten the transit ride; reduce transit transfers; Use a transit system they live outside of, and; Avoid driving downtown. Fourteen lines connect 30 park and rides directly to OHSU. Sixty lots located around the region.

Driving

Pay 8am-5pm on campus. Park free at Park & Rides. With 20,000 visitors a day, low car commutes are essential to access. And due to a City cap on parking, OHSU does not control supply or demand. OHSU thus subsidizes alternatives.

Payment required 8am-5pm weekdays on campus. Select areas restricted 24/7. Park by day via our website. Park by the hour via onsite pay stations.

Patients and their personal visitors park free during appointments. Students must validate their patient parking: On Marquam Hill, call 503-494-8283; At South Waterfront, take a ticket and validate at clinic. Patient parking is otherwise strictly prohibited during paid hours.
