Abstract	Dr. Charles Conrad Carter was a 1948 graduate of University of Oregon Medical School (UOMS) and long-time faculty member of the Neurology Department. He has collected a variety of materials, mostly relating to student days and collected at class reunions in 1988 and 1998.

Biographical note

Charles Conrad Carter was born in Seattle (1924). He completed his undergraduate education at Reed College; then graduated from the University of Oregon Medical School (1948). He returned to join faculty at UOMS as Clinical Professor in Neurology (1956-70). Dr. Carter was promoted to Full Professor (1970). He retired from UOMS (1979) to work in Roseburg's Veteran's Administration Hospital, before returning once again to the Oregon Health Sciences University (OHSU) in 1988 as Clinical Professor.

Scope and Content

The materials consist of a VHS tape, film and two poems regarding school days at UOMS; correspondence with Ben Selling ,M.D.; and a paper on the history of gastroenterolgy.
