Dr. Thomas J. Fox, originally from Marshfield, Oregon, attended the University of Oregon Medical School from 1904 -1908 and graduated with an M.D., in 1909. No other biographical details were known at the time of processing.

## **Scope and Contents**

---

The Thomas J. Fox Collection consists of materials collected while Dr. Fox was a student at the University of Oregon Medical School. It contains 32, small, bound journals of class notes that are in delicate condition (average approximate measurement: 4.5"x7"); Oregon State Medical Board examination questions, 1908-1909 (loose and in folder); a drawing pad with 3 pages of drawings; a text book: "Manual of Physical Diagnosis", by James Tyson, M. D. Philadelphia, P. Blakeston's Son and Co., 1903 (missing front cover) and miscellaneous notes and receipts. See inventory for a detailed description.
