## **Biographical/Historical note**

---

Charles Eddy Dukenfield (1851-1931) M.D., was a graduate of the Buffalo University Medical Department (1882). Raised in Ontario Co., New York. His residence at time of graduation was Allen's Hill, a section of Richmond in that county. He later moved to McMinnville, Oregon (1889). He had the misfortune of most written sources misspelling his name. Larsell's "Doctor in Oregon" has him listed as "L.E. Dukenfield" in McMinnville. Polk's Medical Directory (1890) is one of the few that correctly spell his name. Polk's Directory lists him in consecutive editions 1890-1904.

## **Scope and Contents**

---

The collection primarily consists of 20 class notebooks covering the period 1879-1882 of classes of student Charles E. Dukenfield at the University of Buffalo Medical Department. A set of lecture and school admission tickets, a school catalog for 1915-16 and an example of a prescription recipe of Dukenfield are also included.

Some notes were taken at one end; then for another class the notebook was turned upside down and notes for next class done at the opposite end. The names or subjects connected by a hyphen represent the first and last found in a given notebook.

**Note**

The largest and most distinguishable of the notebooks. It begins as an expense book with living/office expenses of Dukenfield and Scott Wright, presumably a fellow student and roommate, from November-April, no year given. However, class notes begin in Obstetrics with Prof. White, dated November 1879. The second half of the book has many prescription recipes, often including the name of the doctor who originally concocted them.
