## **Biographical/Historical**

The OHSU All-Hill Council ( also known as the OHSU Student Council), is the student government organization for Oregon Health & Science University. Each school (Medicine, Nursing, and Dentistry) contributes members to the council. Two representatives from each class serve on the council for one year. Graduate students and allied health students may also elect a representative. A president, vice president, secretary, treasurer and activities director are elected in May from among council members for the following year. The OHSU Student Council is a member of the Oregon Student Foundation.

The materials date 1988-1989. They were received as a scrapbook, although there were several loose photos as well. The materials were removed from the scrapbook and each item was labeled with the page number from which it came.

Folders 1 and 2 contain photos, OHSU Campus-Gram articles, event flyers, programs (whole and cut up for photo captions), and hand-written photo caption labels.
