In 2003, Judge Nelson received the Oregon Women Lawyers Judge Mercedes Diez award for promotion of minorities in the legal profession. On October 1, 2011, Lewis and Clark Law School named her a distinguished honorary graduate for her mentoring and diversity activities at the school.
