

Resko Faculty Research and Mentoring Achievement Award 2012

The John A. Resko Faculty Research and Mentoring Achievement Award recognizes a faculty member for outstanding research and student mentoring. Nominations are solicited for members of the School of Medicine Graduate Faculty who have a sustained record of high quality research as well as a strong record of mentoring graduate students and/or postdoctoral fellows in their laboratories and subsequent careers.

Nomination packets should include a letter summarizing the candidate's research and mentoring accomplishments, the candidate's curriculum vitae, and a list of mentored students and postdoctoral fellows including their current positions. The most competitive nomination packets typically include supporting letters from faculty colleagues and from current and past-students. Nominations should be sent by campus mail to the Associate Dean for Graduate Studies, L102GS and must be received no later than March 30, 2012.
