The OHSU Division of Management focuses on educating professionals in all areas of the healthcare industry. Our curriculum emphasizes leadership and the business skills needed to make transformative change.

OHSU/PSU MBA in Healthcare Management

Oregon Health & Science University and Portland State University have combined forces to provide Oregon's only MBA in Healthcare Management. PSU's School of Business Administration is providing quality management and business expertise, and OHSU is providing expertise directly related to the healthcare industry.

Designed for anyone with management responsibilities in healthcare including both clinicians with management responsibilities (physicians, nurses, dentists, etc.) and business managers (e.g., finance, operations, marketing, etc.).

The MBA in Healthcare Management program accommodates working professionals through a part-time cohort schedule, allowing for flexibility through a unique combination of online and in-person learning.

The courses are taught in ten week terms with on-campus "residencies" at

OHSU's South Waterfront campus two weekends per term.

This degree is unique in the Pacific Northwest with all coursework directly related to the healthcare industry.

Certificate Program

Healthcare Management

Now entering its ninth year, the Division of Management's Certificate in Healthcare Management offers graduate-level education designed for working professionals in administration, reimbursement, or management roles in healthcare organizations.

The program provides an overview of the financial, policy, organizational and operational environment of healthcare-related enterprises, giving the student focused skills for designing and managing health care organizations such as hospitals, clinics, offices, departments, practices, and companies.

Transferring Certificate Credits

All of the coursework in the Graduate Certificate in Healthcare Management transfers to the OHSU Master of Science in Healthcare Management. The majority of credits transfer into the Joint OHSU-PSU MBA in Healthcare Management.

Master of Science in Healthcare Management

This 52-credit program is geared toward those working on the front lines of management in the healthcare industry. The program focuses on learning and applying management techniques in the workplace. Many of our students have come to realize that they need additional training in order to be more effective in their jobs or to make a bigger impact on their industry. By taking coursework in the M.S. In Healthcare Management Degree they are on their way to realizing those goals and this program is particularly attractive to working professionals who wish to take classes at their own pace. Students pick from an array of highly applied courses that are relevant to their career goals, and take those courses at times that fit into their working lives. Students are required to attend classes two weekends per term; the rest of the coursework is offered in an online format.

The M.S. in Healthcare Management is also an option for professionals from other industries who want to segue into healthcare fields. Like the MBA program, the Master of Science in Healthcare Management finishes with a Capstone course in which students create business plans for real healthcare organizations.

Management in Healthcare

The Division of Management has a primary focus on bringing management expertise to the healthcare industry. All of our programs offer opportunities to:

- Learn and immediately apply effective management skills
- Take classes that are scheduled in a hybrid online and face-to-face schedule to fit into your busy life
- Build your professional network with other successful students and alumni; Our faculty members are industry leaders who are eager to share their years of expertise, knowledge and experiences

Students have many opportunities to meet and learn from guest lecturers throughout the program, which culminates in the Capstone course. Our students form teams to create business and strategy plans for real healthcare organizations.

Healthcare Management: A Field of Significant Growth

According to 2008-09 estimates from the Bureau of Labor Statistics, employment of medical and health services managers is expected to grow 16 percent from between now and 2016, faster than the average for all occupations. The healthcare industry will continue to expand and diversify, requiring managers to help ensure smooth business operations. Median annual earnings of wage and salary medical and health services managers were \$73,340 in May 2009.
