There are currently 3 medical student apartments located at the Connors Entrance of St. Charles Medical Center - Bend.

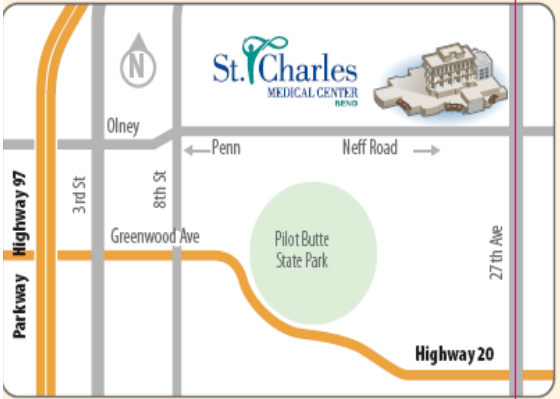
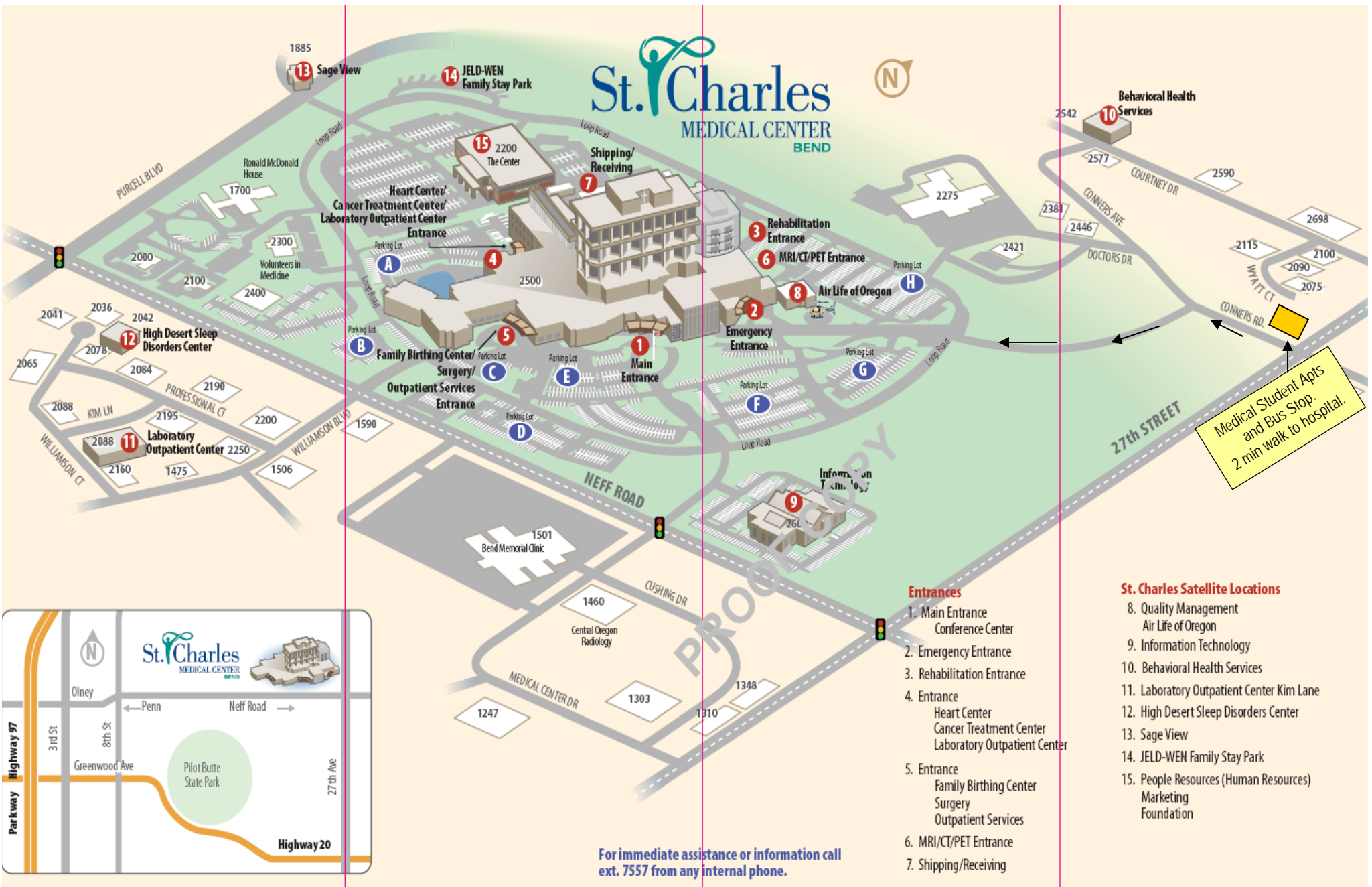
It's a two minute walk to St. Charles and easy walking distance to all clinics involved in the current rotations.
