2. Non Con 3mm x 1.5mm

3. Locator/Tracker: Bolus Track at level of Celiac Artery.

4. Arterial 3mm x 1.5mm 20sec post threshold delay

Thins: .8mm x .4mm

mprs: Sag/Cor 3mm x 1.5mm

5. Portal 3mm x 1.5mm 55sec delay

Thins: 1.5mm x .75 mpr: Cor 3mm x 1.5

6. IV access: 18g

7. PO Prep: 900 ml of Volumen

8. Contrast: Omni 350, 125ml

9. Contrast Rate: 4 - 5 cc per sec.

10. Contrast delay: Bolus Track off Descending Aorta at



## Non Con(Dome to Crest)




Arterial(Dome to Crest)
