



Note - Advancement to Ph.D. candidacy requires successful completion of CON 650: *The Practice and Ethics of Science* (or an approved alternative course), the program's Qualifying Examination and all other academic requirements specified by the Program. Students working toward a Ph.D. degree must take the examination for advancement to candidacy by the end of the third calendar year of graduate study. Students may not take the Qualifying Examination if they are on academic probation or if an Incomplete (I) grade remains on their transcript. Students working toward a Ph.D. degree must be candidates for at least three academic terms.
