

Geriatrician Clinician-Educator

The Division of Hospital Medicine and Division of General Internal Medicine & Geriatrics within the Department of Medicine at Oregon Health & Science University seek qualified candidate for a Clinician-Educator position in our growing Geriatrics program available July 2014. This position will lead development, implementation, operation and evaluation of an interprofessional inpatient geriatric program. The role will involve FTE in the Clinical Hospitalist Service, Medical Teaching Service and time with 1st and 2nd year medical students in small group sessions. The successful candidate should enjoy teaching and the care of general and geriatric patients with a housestaff team and aspire to an academic career. This position will be a joint appointment in the Divisions of Hospital Medicine and General Internal Medicine & Geriatrics, within the Department of Medicine at a rank commensurate with experience and credentials. MD degree (or equivalent) and ABIM certification is required. Applicants at a minimum should have received additional training with a focus in Geriatrics.
