Mr. Kitchen, consultant neurosurgeon and associate clinical director, Victor Horsley Department of Neurosurgery, National Hospital for Neurology and Neurosurgery (NHNN), University College London Hospital Trust, London, England will visit OHSU June 25 to July 2, 2009.

Mr. Kitchen has been a consultant neurosurgeon for more than 10 years. His neurosurgical interests are neuro-oncology, skull base surgery and cerebrovascular disease.

He is actively involved in a translational neurovascular diseases research program and his research has extensive links with neurology, neurochemistry, neuroradiology and neurointensive care within NHNN, as well as in other neurosciences centers.

Mr. Kitchen has published more than 130 peer reviewed articles and more than 25 book chapters, he was the neurosurgeon shadowed by Ian McEwan for his book *Saturday*.
