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# VANDERBILT ADHD DIAGNOSTIC PARENT RATING SCALE (VADPRS)

## Scoring Instructions for the VADPRS:

Behaviors are counted if they are scored 2 (often) or 3 (very often).

<b>Predominantly inattentive subtype</b>	Requires 6 or more counted behaviors on items 1 through 9 and a performance problem (score of 1 or 2) in any of the items on the <b>performance section</b> .
<b>Predominantly hyperactive/impulsive subtype</b>	Requires 6 or more counted behaviors on items 10 through 18 and a performance problem (score of 1 or 2) in any of the items on the <b>performance section</b> .
<b>Combined subtype</b>	Requires 6 or more counted behaviors each on both the inattention and hyperactivity/impulsivity dimensions.
<b>Oppositional-defiant disorder</b>	Requires 4 or more counted behaviors on items 19 through 26.
<b>Conduct disorder</b>	Requires 3 or more counted behaviors on items 27 through 40.
<b>Anxiety or depression</b>	Requires 3 or more counted behaviors on items 41 through 47

The **performance section** is scored as indicating some impairment if a child scores 1 or 2 on at least 1 item.
