Background: The Merwyn “Mitch” Greenlick scholarship was established in 2007. Named after current Oregon State Representative Mitch Greenlick, PhD, the scholarship celebrates his dedication to public health. Mitch continues to make a dramatic impact on the health of everyday people through policy, research, and practice.

Greenlick is the founding Director of the Kaiser Permanente Center for Health Research (CHR) and the former Vice President for Research of the Kaiser Foundation Hospitals. After retiring from the CHR, he served as chair of the Department of Public Health and Preventive Medicine at OHSU from 1990-2000. His tireless skills in collaboration were especially evident as chair as he worked with academic and public health practice colleagues to form the Oregon MPH Program, which includes the Epidemiology and Biostatistics track offered at OHSU.

Some of Greenlick’s accomplishments include:

- Publishing more than 200 books, articles, and papers
- Appointed Distinguished Fellow of the Academy for Health Services Research and Health Policy (now Academy Health)
- 1994 Academy’s President’s Award Recipient for his lifetime contributions to the field of health services research
- Recipient of the Oregon Public Health Association’s 2005 Legislator of the Year Award
- Community Health Partnership’s 2005 Public Health Genius Award

Political Accomplishments:

- Elected to the Oregon House of Representatives in 2002
- Reelected in both 2004 and 2006
- 2007 Chair of the Health Care Committee
- 2007 Chair of the Health Care Subcommittee on Health Care Access
- 2007 Member of the Education Committee and the Higher Education Subcommittee
