The **Continuing Umbrella of Research Experience (CURE)** program is a 8 to 10 week paid research internship where you will be matched with a cancer specific researcher over the summer.

This internship includes weekly scientific seminars and lab meetings that will help you gain real world research experience that will help you differentiate yourself from other students entering college and create contacts that will help you navigate the medical research field.

Ninety eight percent of past participants have matriculated into four-year colleges, including Ivy League institutions.
