

Other Physician Reentry Programs (U.S.)

- Center for Personalized Education for Physicians (CPEP)
Clinical Practice Reentry Program, Denver, CO
Provides information and educational solutions to objectively address physician performance concerns. CPEP also helps evaluate clinical competence of a physician who has been out of practice for an extended period. Physicians complete coursework in Denver and return home for 3 to 9 months of clinical work with a local physician mentor.

Drexel University, Philadelphia, PA
Gives physicians resources to enhance their professional and clinical skills. Three program modules which may be taken in sequence or independently. The program offers a six week internal medicine preceptorship as well as tracks in OBGYN, surgery, and pediatrics.

Over three months, physicians are assessed and an Individualized Educational Plan developed. Physicians complete a mini residency and are evaluated. Then, for one year, physicians participate in redactive chart review.

- Physician Assessment and Clinical Education Program (PACE)
UCSD, San Diego, CA
Educates physicians and other healthcare professionals; detects, evaluates, and remediates deficiencies in medical practice. PEP – onsite mentoring program to provide longitudinal assessment, education and practice-based improvement to participating physicians. PA – 2-Phase, seven day program to evaluate the physician's general clinical knowledge and judgment using the ACGME core competencies
