Located in Oregon's Willamette Valley, the Western Oregon University campus is about 20 minutes from Salem, a little over an hour from Portland, and just over an hour from the coast. With a student body of about 4500 undergraduates and 400 graduate students, WOU is a close-knit community offering a variety of ways to meet other students and get involved in campus life outside of class. Current student clubs and organizations include social, athletic, religious, cultural, educational, service, honorary, and political groups. Many WOU students participate in intramural sports and other recreational activities. Campus facilities include the swimming pool, gym and racquetball courts, weight room, tennis courts, a disc golf course, track, and athletic fields. Campus events include art exhibits, theatre productions, music and dance performances, and intercollegiate athletics.
