This form is intended to help the OHSU School of Nursing determine your progress with taking the prerequisite courses required to matriculate into the accelerated programs for summer term. The Office of Admissions will review your form for accuracy. This program is for students who have or will have a non-nursing bachelor's degree **prior to matriculation** and **do not** have an Associate's Degree or Diploma in Nursing. Transcripts are officially reviewed by the Registrar's Office once a student is admitted.

- To be eligible to apply, one term of A&P must be complete by the end of fall term. _____
- Prerequisite courses can be taken at any accredited community college or university where the course is college level and the grade is "B-" or higher.
- **Science prerequisites – Anatomy and Physiology, Nutrition, Microbiology, Genetics and Statistics must be completed 7 within years prior to matriculating into the program.**

Prerequisite Course Descriptions Accelerated Bachelor of Science Accelerated B.S. to Master's

To help you with your educational planning, please use the following course descriptions to help identify the courses at your institution that will meet our prerequisite requirements. Include course descriptions for ALL prerequisite courses you are planning to use. These descriptions should come from the institution's academic catalog for the year and semester/quarter that the courses were taken.

Anatomy and Physiology = Year long sequence with lab: A full sequence of human anatomy and physiology with laboratory, inclusive of all body systems. This sequence must be taken in its entirety. The first term of A&P must be completed prior to application to the nursing program; the full sequence must be taken prior to the first nursing course. Note: Chemistry or Biology may be required prior to the A&P sequence at some colleges/universities; please check individual college requirements.

Nutrition = One Course: Class should cover biological functions, dietary sources of essential nutrients, and the relationship of diet to health.

Human Development = One Course: Course should cover the social and psychological developmental process of human life covering the full lifespan. Courses that cover only a part of the life span will not be accepted.

Microbiology with lab = One Course: Basic microbiology. If a course in microbiology with laboratory is available for only 3 credits, then this will be accepted.

***Introduction to Genetics (one course or a module within a course):** Any human biology course that includes a **human genetics** component in the course and indicates this inclusion in the college catalog course description. This may not be met through human genetics coverage in a Microbiology or Anatomy and Physiology course.

****Statistics = One Course:** This course should include both descriptive and inferential components. If there is a choice between one type and another, take the descriptive. It is not necessary to take two courses to get inferential statistics. **Applicants to the Accelerated B.S. to Masters program ONLY are required to take statistics within the last 5 years.**
