

OCNE Curriculum for All RNBS Students

OHSU School of Nursing offers all RNs the nursing coursework required for a bachelor's degree. Students who enter the RNBS Program from a Community College partner schools move directly into the 400-level nursing courses. Students who are not from an OCNE Community College must complete the four "transition" courses (NRS 301, 302, 303 and 304) and then move into the senior level nursing courses. All RNBS students graduate with the same degree. Students must complete non-nursing required courses at other universities or community colleges. Program length will vary depending upon the student's previous education and the number of courses taken each quarter.
